

Make your own Mini-Word Garden!

If you'd like to develop a physical "word wall" based on a children's book or science project, try this.



Materials:

1. Wood box, approximately 15" square*
2. Aquarium gravel for the "bed" **
3. Stones (collect in nature or purchase in flower arranging sections of craft stores)
4. Markers: We used "Foamies" for writing on foam products, but you can use anything that will show up and you can eventually wash off for re-using the stones. For very temporary uses, try chalk.
