One, Two, Tree! Let's Learn about the Linden!

A tree activity for little **Seedlings** (Children ages 4-7)

Activity: Tree Investigation!

Materials Needed:

- ✓ Paper
- ✓ Crayons

Procedure:

How **wide** is the trunk?

- 1.) Find the trunk of the tree.
- 2.) Wrap your arms around the tree trunk. Do your arms fit?

How **tall** is the tree?

- 1.) Lift your arms up into the air.
- 2.) Can you reach the leaves or branches of the tree?
- 3.) Can an adult reach?
- 4.) Have an adult stand next to the tree. Is he/she taller or smaller than the tree?
- 5.) Stand in the shadow of the tree. Is your shadow bigger or smaller?

What **Color** are the leaves?

- 1.) How many different colors do you see? Count them.
- 2.) Draw the different colors on a piece of paper.

What are the **parts** of the tree?

- 1.) See if you can name all the different parts of the tree.
- 2.) Write down the parts on a piece of paper.

What do you see *in*, **on**, or *around* the tree?

- 1.) Do you see any insects, birds, berries, pieces of bark, etc.?
- 2.) Record your findings of a piece of paper.



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
