The VGA has copies of 3 different maps from the National Geographic Society free for educators. They are:

#1 *Climate Change:* maps of temperature and precipitation change on one side, and a poster of Greenhouse Earth on the other.

#2 *The Dividing Line:* map of Mexico and Central America with political boundaries on one side and land cover on the other.

#3 *Poster of Australia* from NG Kids: a map of Australia couples with a few activities.

#4 *World Map (once side centered on the Prime Meridian, the other on the Pacific – post and then switch it around!)*

#5 *China:* A detailed full size of map of the country on one side, a rendering of the Forbidden City and a timeline on the other.

#6 *Dinosaurs:* A map with supporting text on dinosaurs

#7 *Earth Pulse:* 120 page book on global trends with maps, photos and text.
