7. Where do voice actors generally get the most wide-spread and **popular acclaim or recognition**? By **whom**? Why does this tend to occur?
8. What are the major **challenges** that a voice actor faces in performing for the following forms of media:
  - a. **Film/TV**
  - b. **Animation/Cartoons**
  - c. **Video Games**
