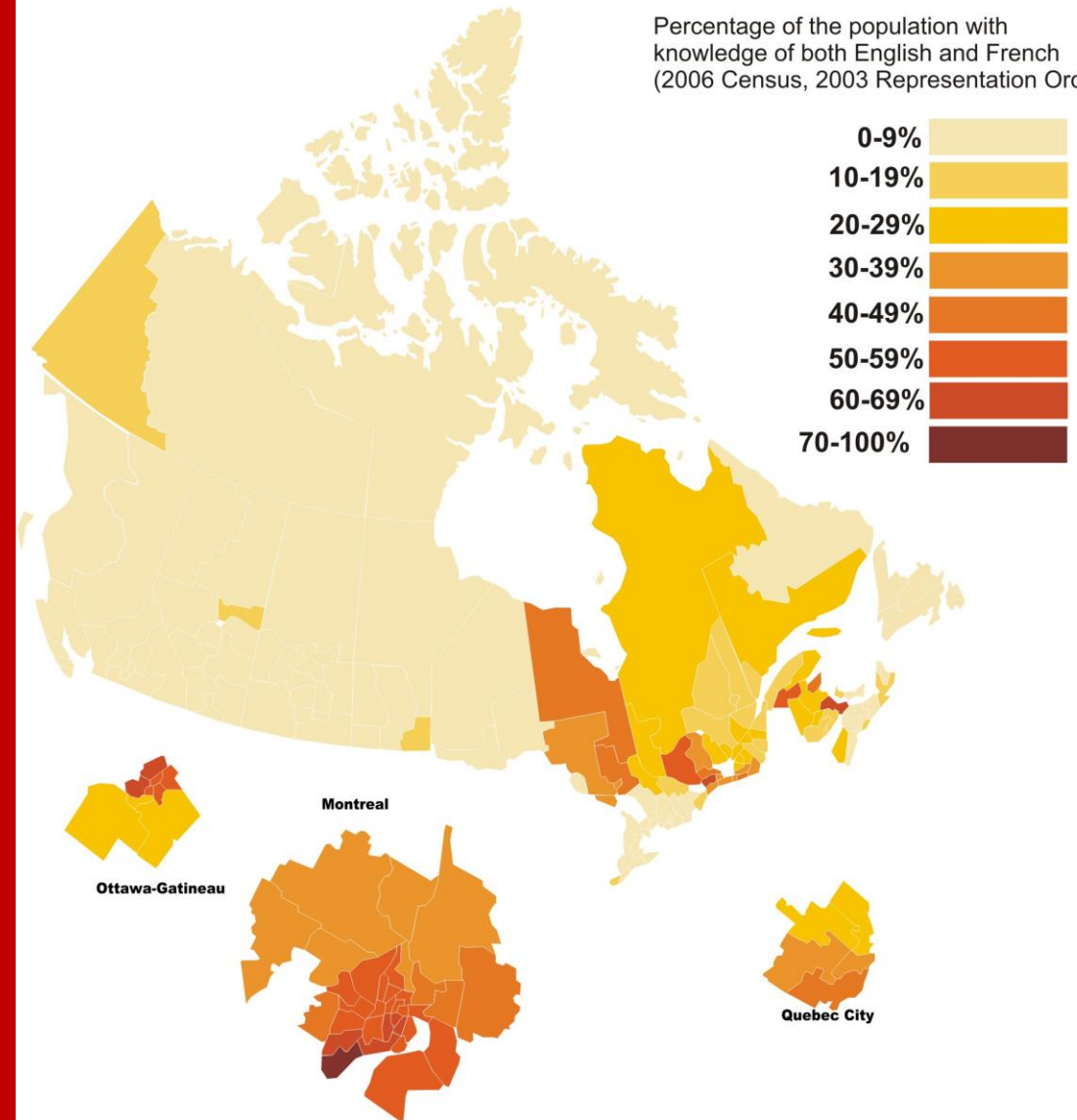

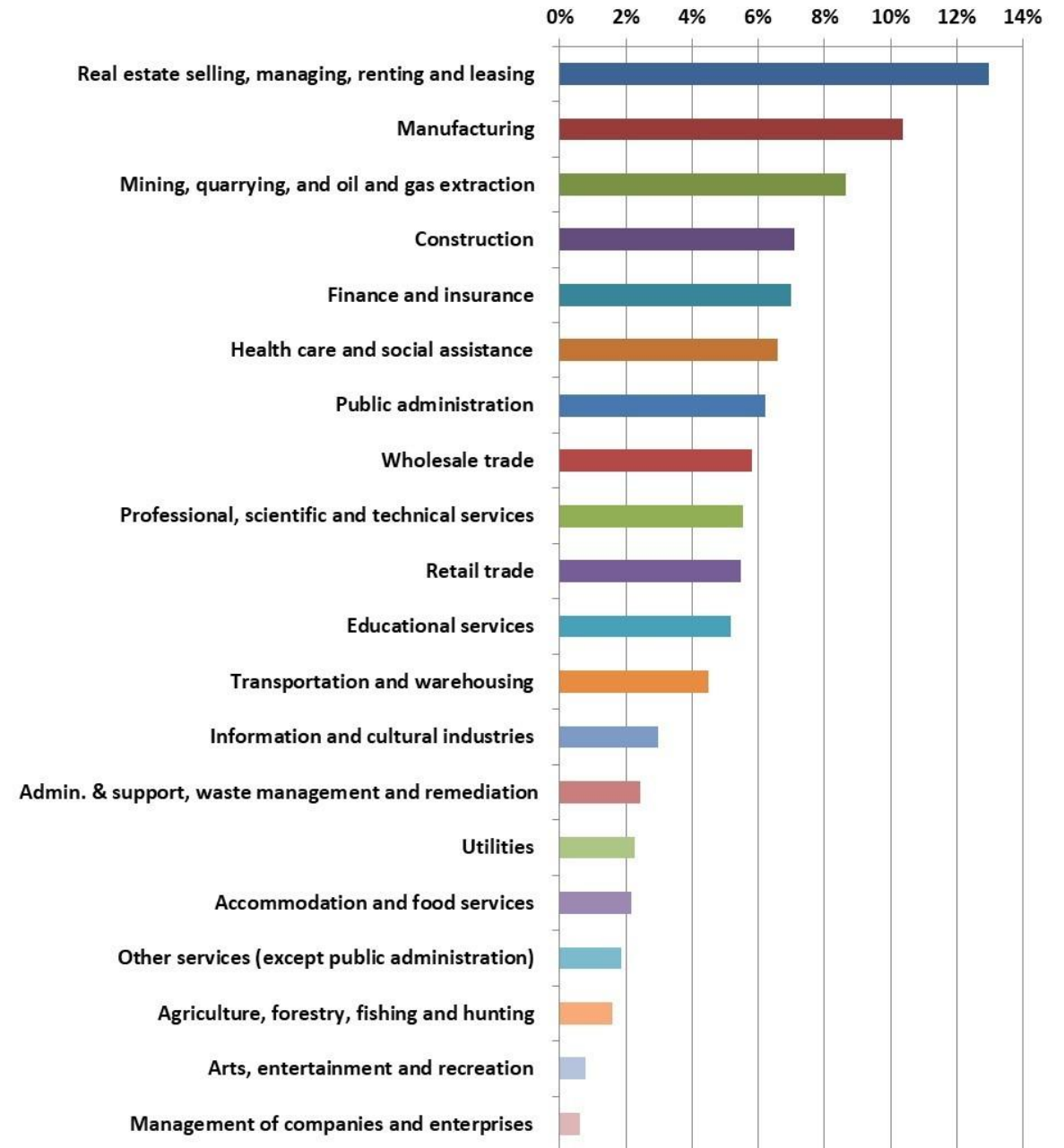

Canada UN “livability” or HDI?

- The Human Development Index (HDI) is a composite statistic of life expectancy, education, and income per capita.
 - A country scores higher HDI when the life expectancy at birth is longer, the education period is longer, and the income per capita is higher.
- Canada’s livability = #10 in the world
- HDI (2018) #12
- Norway = #1
