




NGOs and I-NGOs

The World Bank defines a non-governmental organization (NGO) as:

The idea originated from the United Nations (UN) following WWII (1945)

1.An organization which operates independently from any government or "inter-governmental organization" (such as the UN)



- → relieve suffering
- promote the interests of the poor
- protect the environment
- provide basic social services, or
- undertake community development





INGO and the United Nations

- To be affiliated with the United Nations, an INGO MUST follow these certain criteria:
 - The NGO must support and respect the principles of the Charter of the United Nations and have national or international standing;
 - Should operate solely on a not-for-profit basis and have tax-exempt status;
 - **3. Commitment to communication** through newsletters, bulletins and pamphlets; organizing conferences, seminars and round tables; or enlisting the attention of the media;
 - 4. It should provide a **transparent process** of taking decisions, reporting finances, and holdingelections of officers and members of the Board of Directors.
 - Should have an established record of continuity of work for a minimum of three years and should show promise of sustained activity in the future.
