

# INTROS and Sample Sections for Senior Seminar

On **Wednesday, March 11th**, several critical pieces of your senior seminar project are due. Be prepared to present them in class on that Wednesday.

## E~Book Projects:

All of the following elements in layout:

- Cover/Layout of your E~Book with Title AND Subtitle of your Book
- Table of Contents - Chapters with Thematic titles - subtitles
- Introduction/HOOK in layout
- 'Sample' Chapter(s) (Pick one chapter and write it. **Present it in layout with visuals** and live links)

Turn in a paper version. Also have your digital files in your senior seminar class folder. **USE LAST NAMES in your file names.**

## Web Documentary Projects:

All of the following elements:

- Homepage/Landing Page of your Site
- Overall Site Layout with Site Masthead and Complete Navigation (showing TITLE and subtitle of your site and the sections that will be there.)
- Introduction and HOOK to your site (including written sections, images, video etc.)
- 'Sample' Section(s) of your site (Pick one section and write it and create it. Present it in layout with visuals, audio, etc.)
- Written/Mapped LAYOUT of all of your Titled/Subtitled Chapters and projected times

Have your files in your senior seminar class folder. Print the web pages to turn them in, along with a sheet of paper that has the URL address or name of folder/files. **USE LAST NAMES in your file names.**

Over the course of the next few weeks, it would be a good idea to get a fresh set of eyes on certain aspects that you've been working on—your introduction, your title, your cover, your landing page, your web design, your book design. Show these pieces to someone who is unfamiliar with your project in order to get their impressions and suggestions.

## Documentary Film Projects:

All of the following elements:

- Introduction/HOOK to your Film including dynamic B-roll (Voice over? On camera?)
- Title/Subtitle Screen Revealed
- 'Sample' Chapter(s) of your film including full B-roll
- Written/Mapped LAYOUT of all of your Titled/Subtitled Chapters and projected times

Have your files in your senior seminar class folder. **USE LAST NAMES in your file names.**
