## **Types of Questions**

- 1. Short Answer-- Qualify your answers with examples which are drawn directly from the SCREENINGS, LECTURES, READINGS, DEMOS and DISCUSSIONS.
- 3. Application of Reading & Theory → Hook, Intro, Character Development, Story progression, Turning Points, etc.
- **4. Film Development→** Writing film Treatments, shot lists, logistics, Conceptualization and Planning→Knowledge of the "behind the scenes" development.
- 5. **SCREENINGS**: Critical analysis of in and out of class screenings and semiotic moments. Review screenings and screening guides.
- 6. Canon D80 cameras. Strong and detailed working knowlegdge of menus, options, settings, lens features, audio, etc.
